Mark Berriau wins ARCA West OK Tire Touring Race number 6 at Sunvalley Speedway in Vernon

Race 6 of the ARCA West OK Tire Sportsman series was held at the beautiful Sunvalley speedway. The weather couldn't have been better for the points Championship weekend. Qualifying had Matt Stephenson set the fastest time of the night at a 19.003. Berriau was second fast and 2008 WCSS champion Steve Lengert 3rd quick. New father Darren Swaan celebrated with a win in the B heat, Babcock second and the 38 car of Lee Thomas third. A heat Winner and 2008 WESCAR champ Sheldon Mayert was chased hard by the 3 of Logan Jewel and the 12 car of Calvin Loudoun.

The feature set up with a 14 car invert, leaving less than 4 tenths of a second between the front group. The 71 car of Dave Olsen set the pace, with Swaan on the outside pole. Olsen took the lead, and lead the first 9 laps with Ron Larson making the move to the top spot on lap 10. A twitchy car would have Larson give up the lead to young gun Dustin Lengert. As the front of the pack diced, the points contenders were methodically working through traffic. The 5 car of Bob Williams looking for every point and the 27 points leader Mark Berriau protecting his precious points lead. With every yellow, the 58 car of Dustin Lengert held onto the race lead with perfect restart strategy. A late race yellow reset the field when the third place car of Ron Larson, and the number 52 of Garnett Grimard touch and tangled in turn 3. The 12 car of Calvin Loudoun is showing its strength in third, with Berriau pressuring. Shane Harding, driving the 38 car of Lee Thomas, has worked his way into the fray in the 6th spot. The last 25 laps leave 16 cars on the lead lap, and everyone running side by side to try and better their position. Berriau passes the 58 for the lead and Dustin Lengert holds hard onto second. Williams and Loudoun fight for the third spot, as Harding shows up in fifth. Williams manages the pass for third. As Berriau races to the stripe on the last lap, no challengers, lengert solid in second, Williams third with Loudoun holding off Harding for the fourth spot. Congrats to Mark Berriau for the race and championship win. The hard working Williams team earned second in the points, and the Rix racing number 6 car battled through adversity to clinch the 3rd points position. A great year of racing for the ARCA West OK tire series. Thanks to all of the racers, sponsors and volunteers for an amazing year.
